ORGANIZATIONAL CAPACITY

14,911 active volunteers

4,187 employees (including full-time, part-time and casual staff, rapid responders & delegates)

DISASTERS & EMERGENCIES IN CANADA

\$49.8M+ million provided in mass financial assistance to **more than 95,000** households impacted by Hurricane Fiona

2,500+ personnel deployed in support of medium and large-scale responses

On average, the Canadian Red Cross assisted **78** individuals daily who were impacted by a personal disaster, such as a house fire

1,800+ households supported through case management, and housing repair and reconstruction assistance

3 large-scale disasters or emergencies supported

12 recovery operations Responded to

2,550 emergency responses in Canada last year

260,000+ people in Canada supported by the Red Cross after an emergency

Provided **approximately 21,000** relief items to assist people such as cots, blankets, teddy bears, hygiene kits, and other essential items to help during a disaster or emergency

56 deployments of clinical and non-clinical emergency response workers for Health Human Resources operations to support health centres during shortages of healthcare personnel

6 engagements including testing, isolation, vaccination, and long-term care home support

137 community organizations received grants to support mental health initiatives

\$8.8M committed to support mental health initiatives related to COVID-19

HEALTH

289,000 pieces of health equipment loaned (walkers, wheelchairs, crutches, etc.)

258,000 meals delivered to those unable to prepare their own food so they can live independently

82,000 transportation rides provided to those unable to use public transportation or private means

54,000 friendly calls provided to people

855,000 people trained in First Aid

149,000 people participated in Swimming and Water Safety courses

27,000+ COVID-19 vaccines administered by Red Cross in Ontario

330+ sites supported with clinical and non-clinical health personnel in support of COVID-19 vaccination efforts in Ontario and British Columbia

Supported **450+** sites with epidemic prevention and control services

COLLABORATING WITH INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES

291 Indigenous communities and organizations supported by the Help Desk

3,748 connections with Indigenous communities and organizations for Help Desk support

317 Help Desk community consultations

206 tools/resources developed or adapted by the Help Desk

13 communities supported with evacuations from flood and fires across **3** provinces

291 Indigenous communities supported in preparing and responding to the pandemic both virtually and in-community

STRENGTHENING COMMUNITIES

82 Community Organizations supported following or in preparedness for disruptive events, this includes support to **26** organizations related to mental health, and **21 organizations supported** for disaster risk and reduction

260 Small Businesses supported with recovery efforts following 2 major disasters

5,292 people participated in Disaster Preparedness Workshops

178 Violence Risk Reduction and Community Wellness and Protection workshops provided

1,849 community organizations in rapid-test screening and distribution program, with over **3.6 million** rapid tests and **3.8 million** masks provided

53,000+ contacts made with people for mental health and psychosocial support

GLOBAL CONTRIBUTIONS

\$127M+ in financial contributions to global Red Cross Red Crescent efforts

1.7M+ Personal Protective Equipment kits distributed internationally

29 long-term programs provided in **21** countries

93 delegates deployed to assist in **29** countries

9 Emergency Response Unit delegates deployed internationally to support other National Societies

78 countries assisted globally
